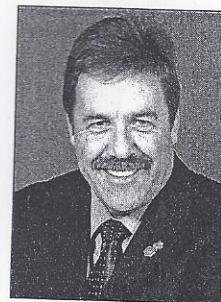

Re: Daylighting Sawmill River

I would like to offer my support to the Ecology Action Centre (EAC) and the Sackville Rivers Association (SRA) in their efforts to “daylight Sawmill River” in Dartmouth.

I am asking you to consider their proposal to daylight Sawmill River, in conjunction with Halifax Water, on the corridor between Sullivan’s Pond and the Harbour. In 2026, the Shubenacadie Canal will be celebrating its 200th anniversary. The completion of this project could be an opportunity for urban renewal, community development, heritage interpretation and environmental protection. 
